

Natives, Redwoods and other trees for Fall planting

Fall is the best time to plant new shade trees, shrubs and that windbreak or privacy screen you've wanted all summer. New fall plantings will not have to face hot weather (and the need for much supplemental watering) for almost seven months. Don't worry about winter cold harming fall plantings. Roots are well insulated in the ground and a three inch layer of mulch can provide added winter protection.

Selection at the nursery includes:

Natives:

Douglas fir (*Pseudotsuga menziesii*) - #5 pot - 4-5' - \$14.99

Vine Maple (*Acer circinatum*) - #15 pot 4-5' tall - \$39.99; larger sizes available @ \$69.99 to \$99.99

Grand Fir (*Abies grandis*) #15 5-6' for \$39.99; larger sizes available

Western Red Cedar (*Thuja plicata*) #10 pots 5-6' tall \$34.99
6-7' tall \$39.99

'Excelsa' Western Red Cedar - somewhat shorter and fuller than species -
5-6' #20 pot \$49.99
very large 10-12' \$119.99

Incense Cedar (*Calocedrus decurrens*) - #25 pot 5-6' tall - \$59.99

Weeping Alaska Cedar or Yellow Cedar (*Chamaecyparis nootkatensis*) -
Many varieties and sizes available, example:
#5 pot, variety Green Arrow - 30-36" tall for \$29.99
or 5-6' tall variety Pendula - \$79.99
other sizes up to 10-12' at various prices.

Mountain Hemlocks (*Tsuga mertensiana*) -
30-36" \$39.99 - container grown trees
collected trees - 5-6' for \$89.99; larger sizes available

Western hemlocks (*Tsuga heterophylla*) - nursery grown - 6-7' for \$79.99

Garry Oak - Oregon White Oak (*Quercus garryana*) #10 pot 5-6' for \$49.99

Alpine firs (*Abies lasiocarpa*) - collected trees - \$79.99 and up

Murrayana pines (*Pinus contorta* subsp. *murrayana*) - high elevation
contorted pines - collected - \$89.99 and up

And of course we have evergreen huckleberry (*vaccinium ovatum*), red
huckleberry (*vaccinium parviflorum*, Kinnikinnick (*artostaphylos uva-*

ursi), Oregon Grape - tall and compacta (*Mahonia aquifolium*) and salal (*Gaultheria shallon*).

Redwoods:

Giant redwood (*Sequoiadendron giganteum*) - #25 8-10' \$59.99

Powder Blue Giant Redwood - # 15 6-7' for \$79.99

Glaucum Blue giant Redwood - #25 6-7' for \$79.99

Pendula - weeping Giant Redwoods #15 5-6' for \$79.99; 9-10' \$199.99

Dawn Redwood (*Metasequoia glyptostroboides*) - 6-7' \$59.99, 8-10' \$89.99

Gold Rush dawn redwood - 5-6' for \$59.99

Albo spicata Coast Redwood (*sequoia sempervirens*)

#15 pot 5-6' for \$69.99

Others:

Leyland cypress (*cupressocyparis x leylandii*) - great for windbreaks or screens - deer resistant -

#5 4-5' tall \$19.99; 10 or more \$19.

Gold Rider - variegated yellow - slower growing and fuller than species

4-5' for \$89.99

5-6' for \$99.99

7-8' for \$119.99

Nordmann fir (*abies nordmanniana*) - similar to Noble fir but more disease resistant - #15, 4-5' for \$39.99; larger sizes available.

Frasier fir (*abies fraseri*) #15, 4-5' for \$39.99; larger sizes available.

And many others.

So many to choose from: it's best to visit the nursery to choose your trees.
